Our topic for the spring term is all about 'Trading and Economics' so this will be linking into Geography, History and Art. It will also be crossing over into our literacy work where we will be looking at text types such as Poetry, Balanced Arguments and Story settings. In Maths we will be looking at things including Percentages, Statistics, Ratio and Problem Solving. In Science we will be looking at 'Light'.

Homework will be set on Fridays and children will record this in their Homework Diaries. Each week they will receive a Maths and English homework (to be completed by the following Wednesday) alongside weekly spellings and times tables (which will be tested the following Friday).
