Dear Parents / Carers,

It is with regret that we have had to take the decision to close school from Wednesday 19th December - Friday 21st December. This means that the children will break up for the Christmas holiday on Tuesday 18th December 2018, after the Key Stage 2 concert at 6.00p.m.

For the past few weeks we have had some trouble with the boiler and water tanks. Engineers have been able to do temporary repairs to keep the school warm and running as normal. To mend the system fully the engineers need to completely drain the tanks and pipes, remove any system blockages and refill the system. Hopefully this will solve the issues we have been experiencing. This process is estimated to take at least 3 days to do. As the water system has to be completely drained, it means that there is no hot water; no heating and we will not be able to flush the toilets. Therefore we cannot have children on site.

Due to this, we are moving Party Day to Monday 17th December. Children will be able to come to school in Christmas jumpers and enjoy party time in their classrooms. 100% club will happen as normal on Tuesday 18th December. The Key Stage 2 Christmas Concert will also take place as planned. Unfortunately, we will have to cancel the Christmas Dinner which was due to happen on Wednesday 19th December.

Tuesday 18th December – 100% club and Key Stage 2 Christmas Concert to start at 6.00p.m. All Key Stage 2 children need to return to school at 5.45pm (not before as the gates will not be open)

Tuesday 18th December – Last day of term. (KS 2 Dodgeball will take place as usual)



Monday 7th January 2019 – Training Day – School closed to pupils

Tuesday 8th January 2019 – School re-opens to pupils.
